USES

FORAGE

Presto has an upright growth habit and is wellsuited for planting by itself or with other species. It has greener leaves than other varieties and shows great regrowth. The low sugar levels found in Presto, combined with soft leaves make it ideal for horse feed.

HAY

Presto is easy to harvest and highly productive in the first year, which is not typical of other timothy varieties. Presto's bunch-type growth habit works well in mixes with legumes, and is the gold standard for hay. It is easily cured, capable of producing bright, clean hay that is free from dust and mold, and can be handled with little waste.

WILDLIFE

Presto is attractive to big game animals. The highly desirable seeds are readily consumed by game birds.
